



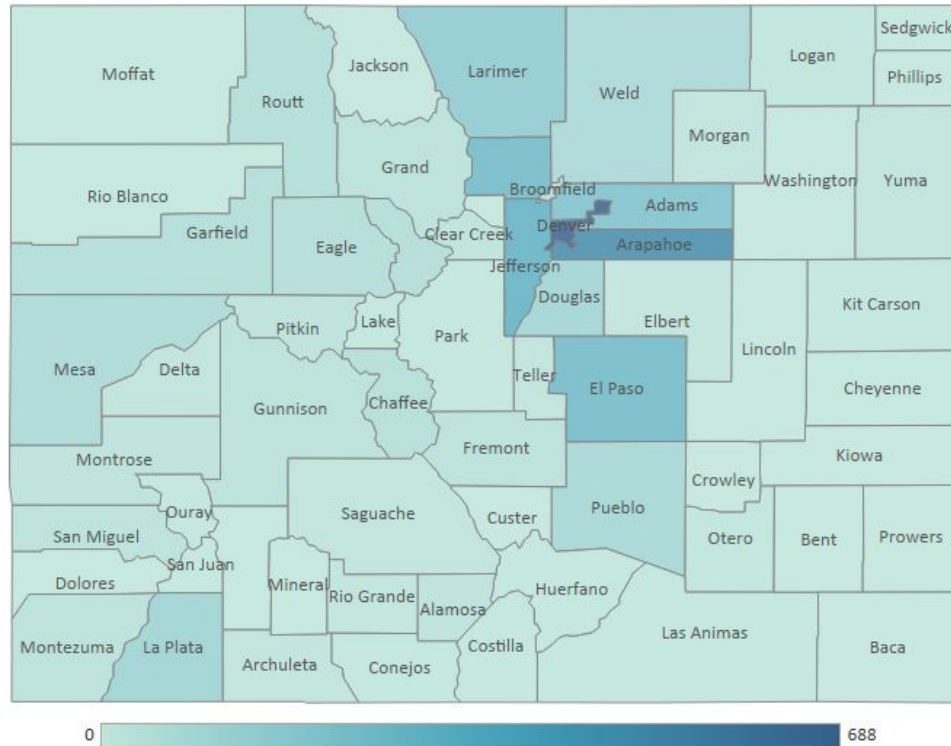

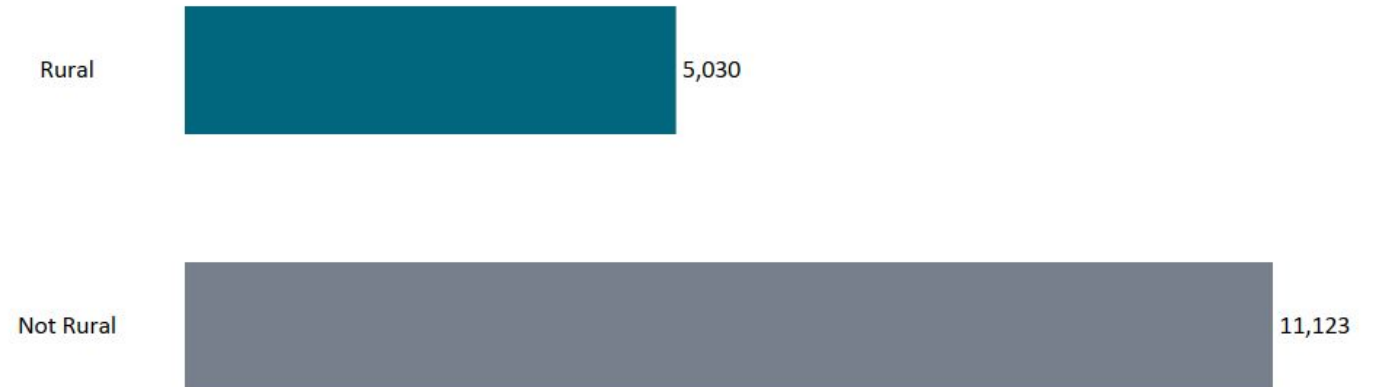
Awarded Grant Dollars



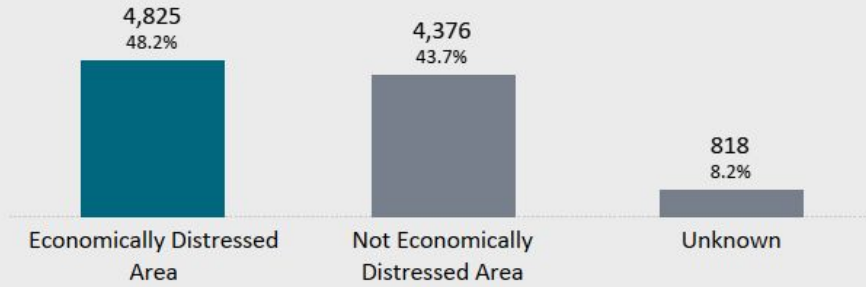
Average Awarded Grant Amount

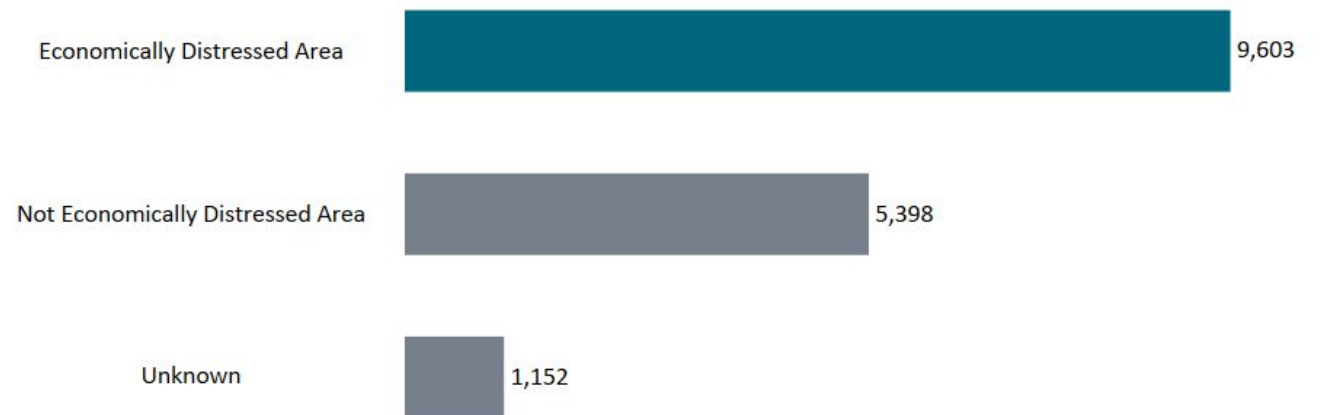

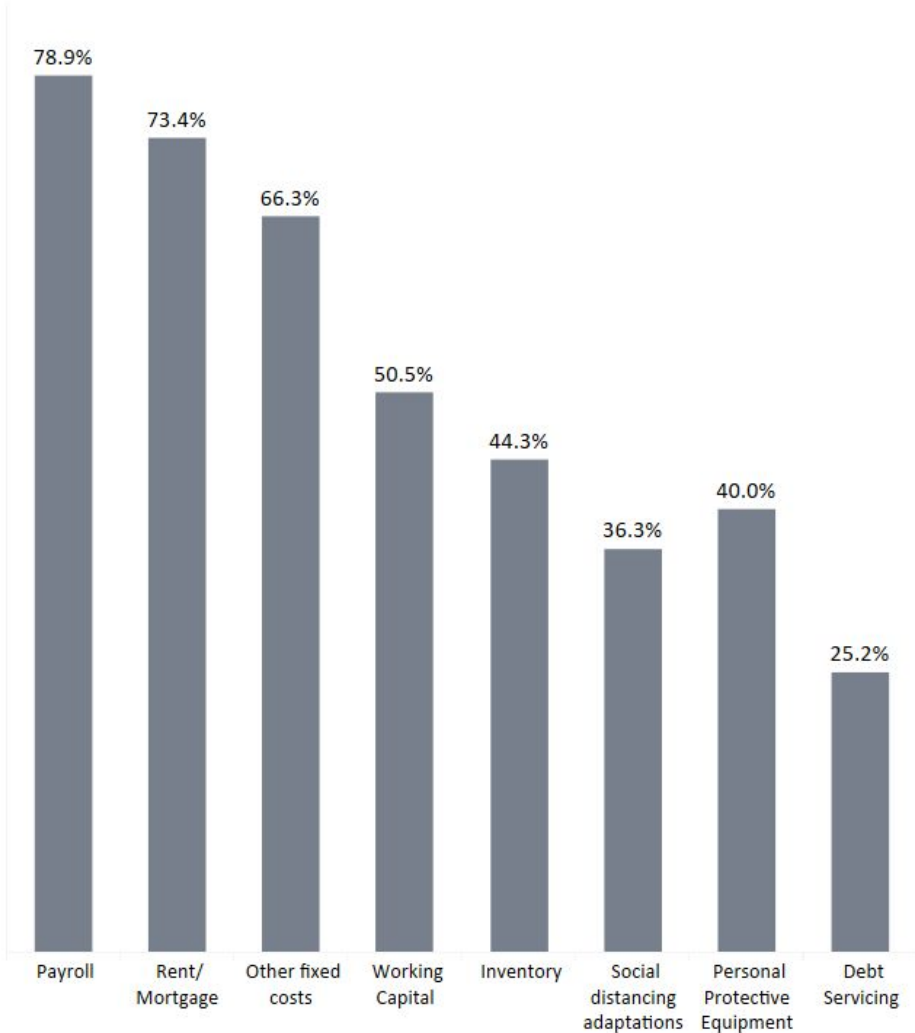

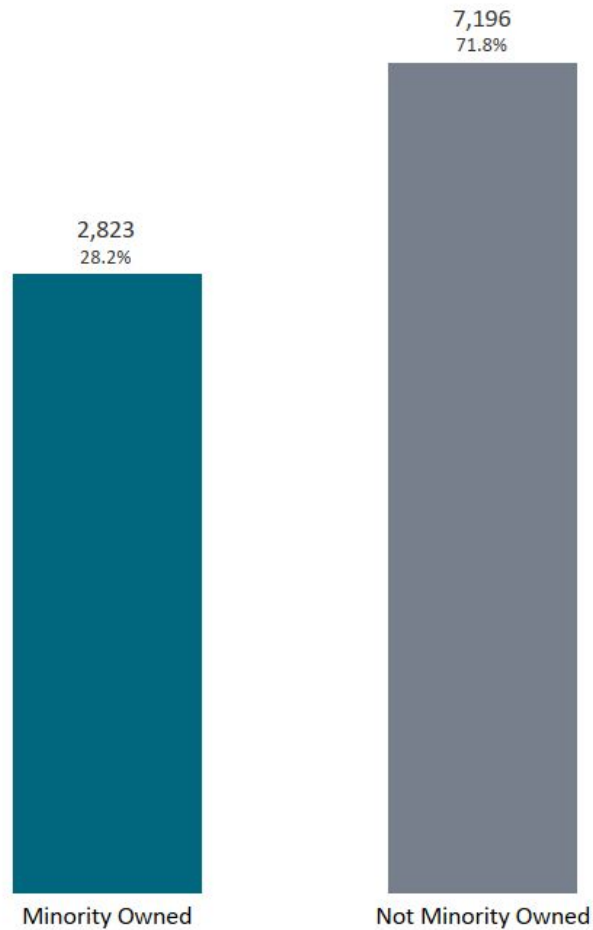
Sole Proprietorship Awardees by Round

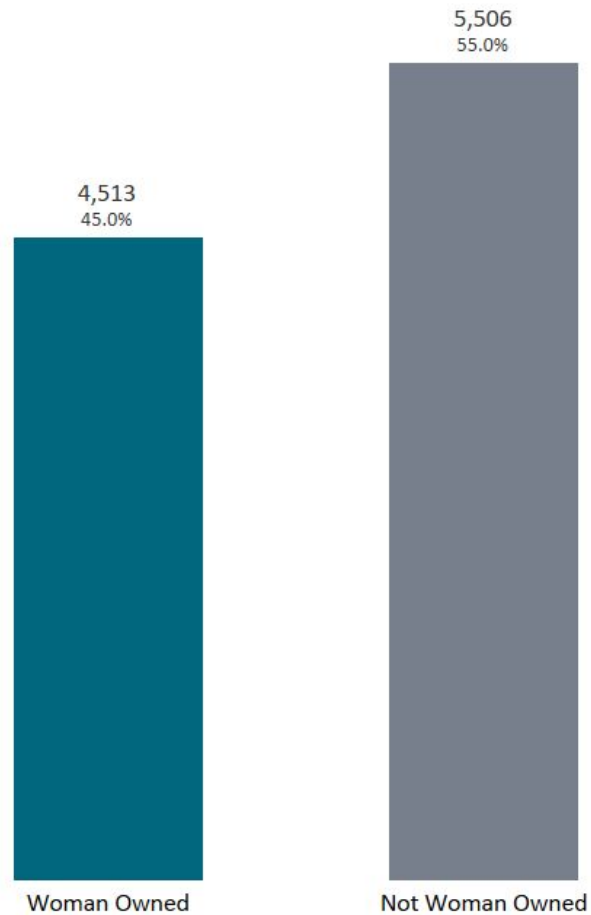


Total Applications for Priority Groups with Over 50% Ownership*

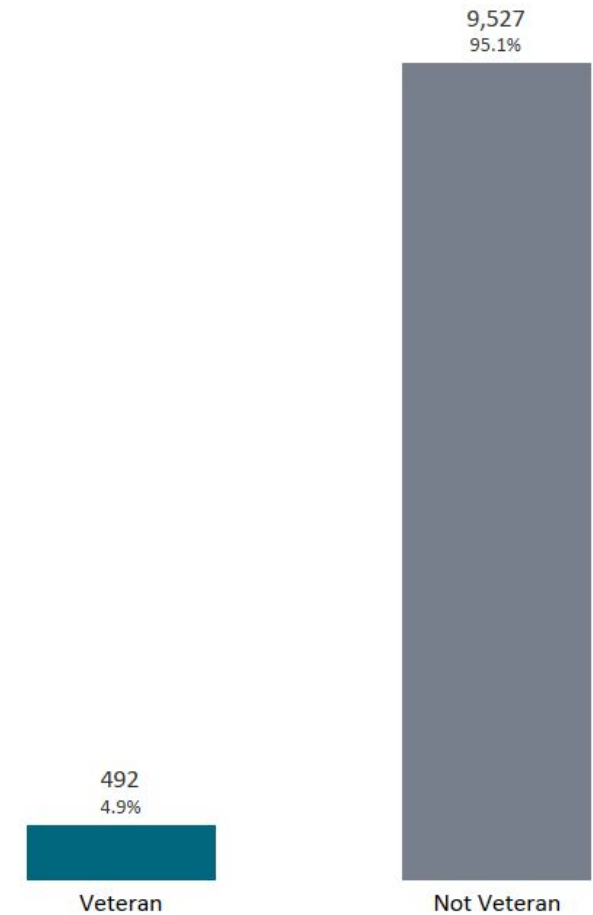

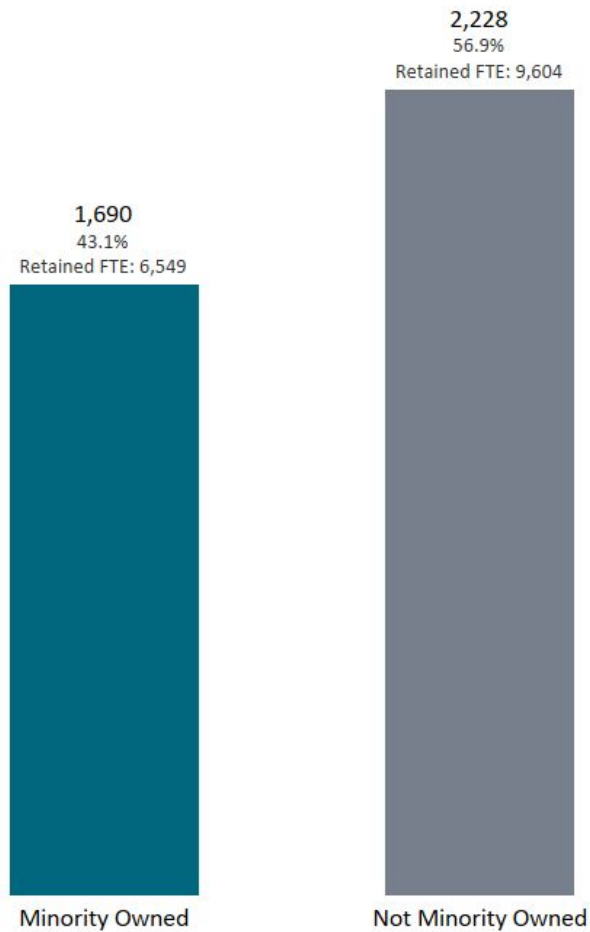

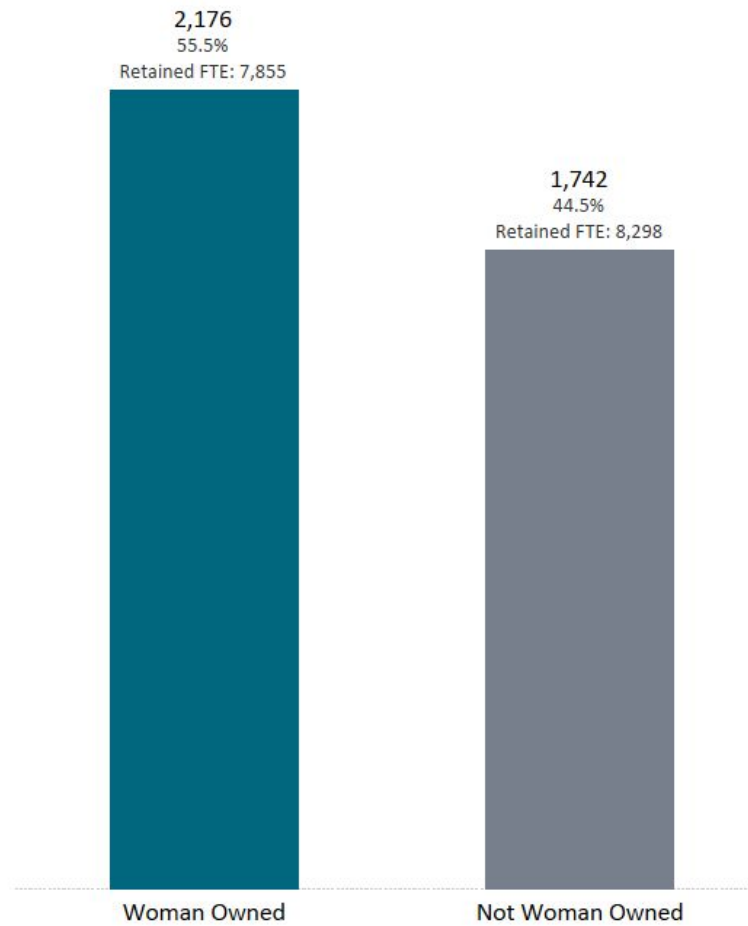

Total Awarded Grants for Priority Groups with Over 50% Ownership*

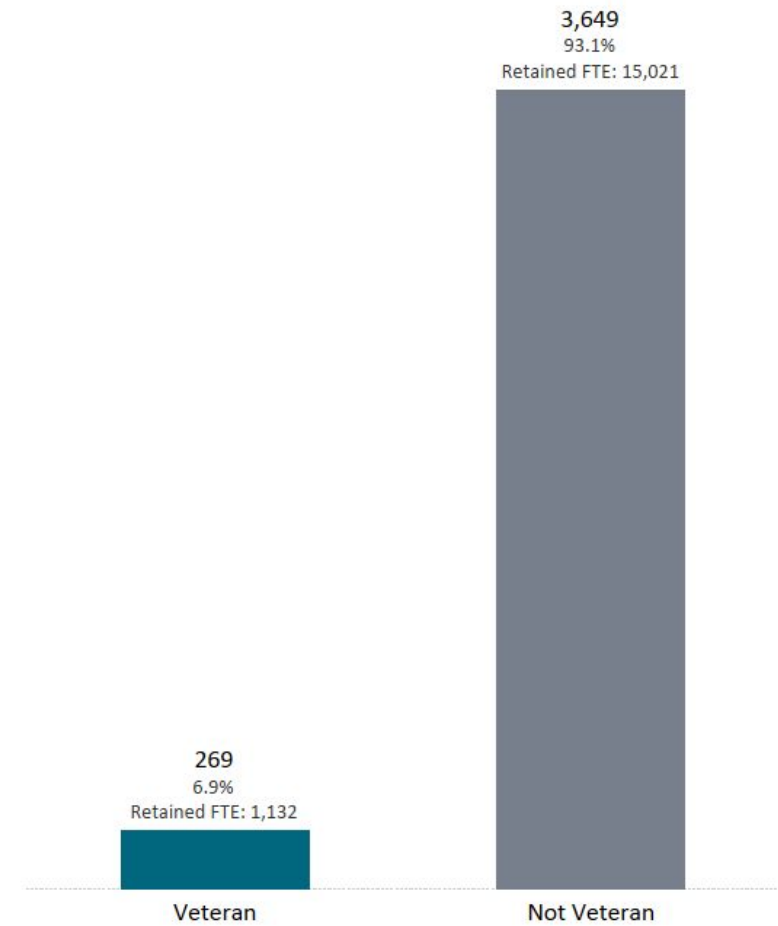

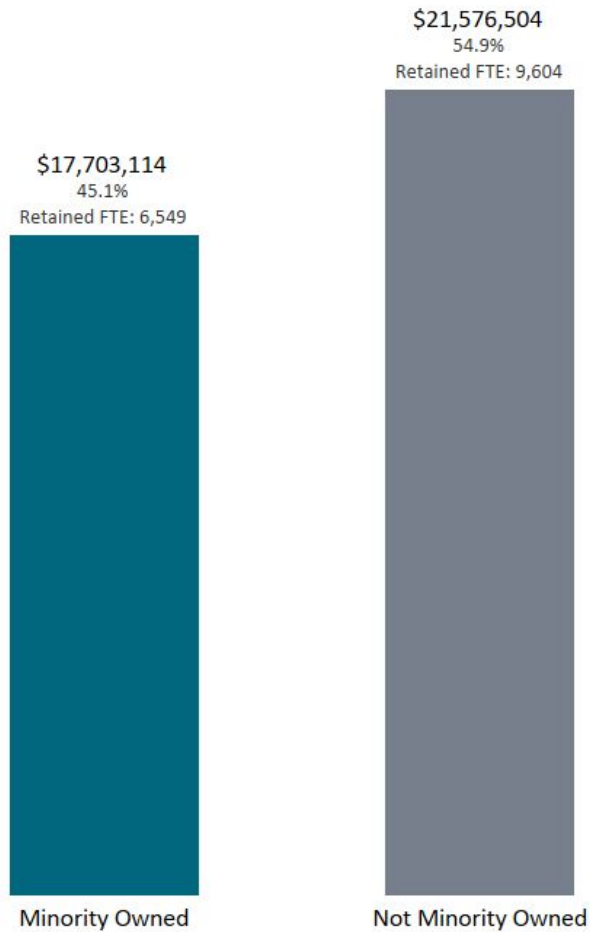

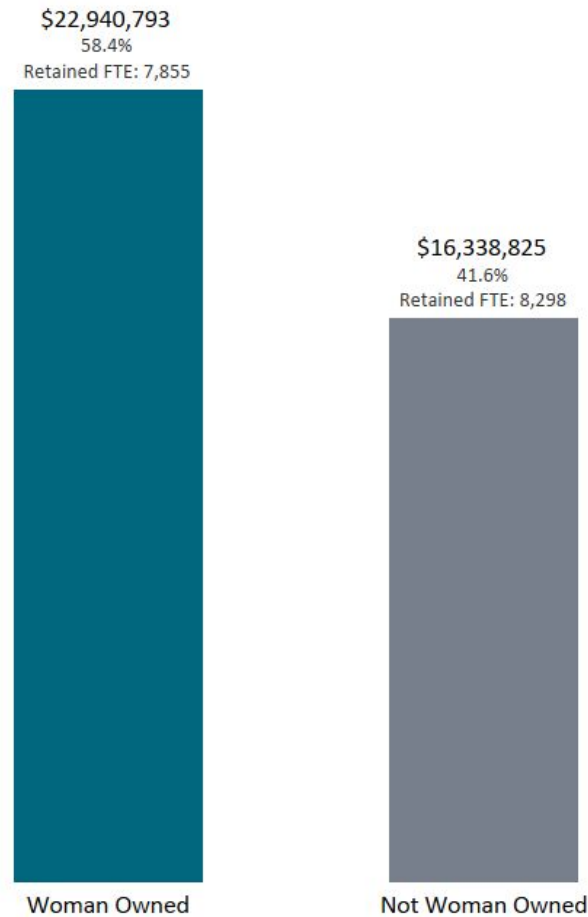
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Total Awarded Grant Amounts for Priority Groups with Over 50% Ownership*

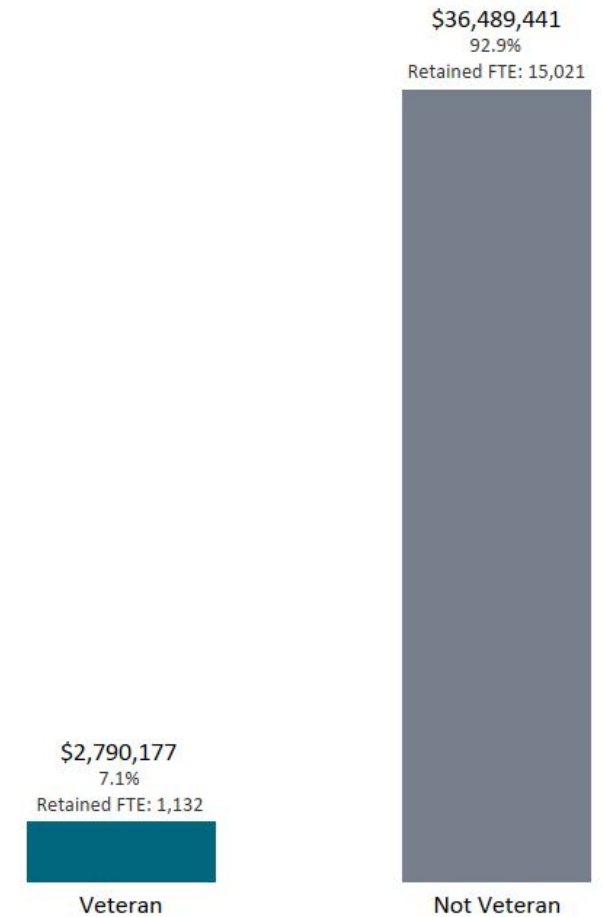

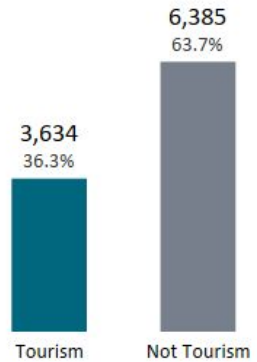

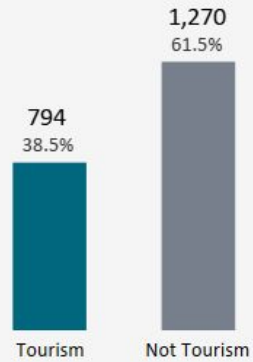

Tourism vs Not Tourism - 2020 Round

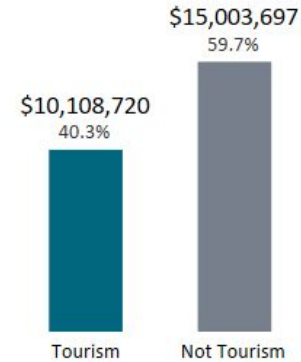
