Maloney, 4 Cooperatives have received their reimbursement grant from Round One of the EO Trial Grant; Round 2's application round closed June 4th, we have awarded 12 businesses and they now have until August 27th to officially convert. Our third round will offer 40 or

	 2021 to try to capture conversions that are naturally occurring at the close of the year. Loan Update - N. Maloney, HB 21-1241 was signed by the Governor on May 21st. Thank you to K. Siggins and J. Wiener for their testimony at both hearings. The EO Office will be working with J. Kraft's team, CHFA and lenders over the coming months to get the new offering in place. Tax Credit Update - N. Maloney, HB 21-1311 passed last week and is headed to the Governor for signing. Credits will be available for a 5-year period for newly forming ESOPs (\$150,000), Employee Ownership Trusts and Cooperatives (\$25,000). The EO Office in partnership with J.
