




Overview of Provisional Applicants *Counties*

Serves Majority Rural Counties?





Phase 1 Regional Distribution


Phase 2 Regional Distribution

Provisional Applicants for the Opportunity Now Phase Two Grant competition were selected based on a competitive application review. The next step in the Opportunity Now competitive grant process is the technical adjustments segment of the grant competition. This phase may include:

- budget adjustments,
- partner modifications, and/or
- scope and focus adjustments

Additionally, provisional applicants will need to advance through a formal due diligence process. As such, provisional grant applicants listed in the following slides are not considered formal grant applicants until completion of all required processes. No awards have been issued and this phase should not be considered an intent to award.








Regions Served by Phases 1 and 2 *Healthcare*

Additional service across all regions of Colorado, with Central Western Slope and Northwest Colorado in particular gaining more representation






Regions Served by Phases 1 and 2 *Educational Services (all)*






Regions Served by Phases 1 and 2










