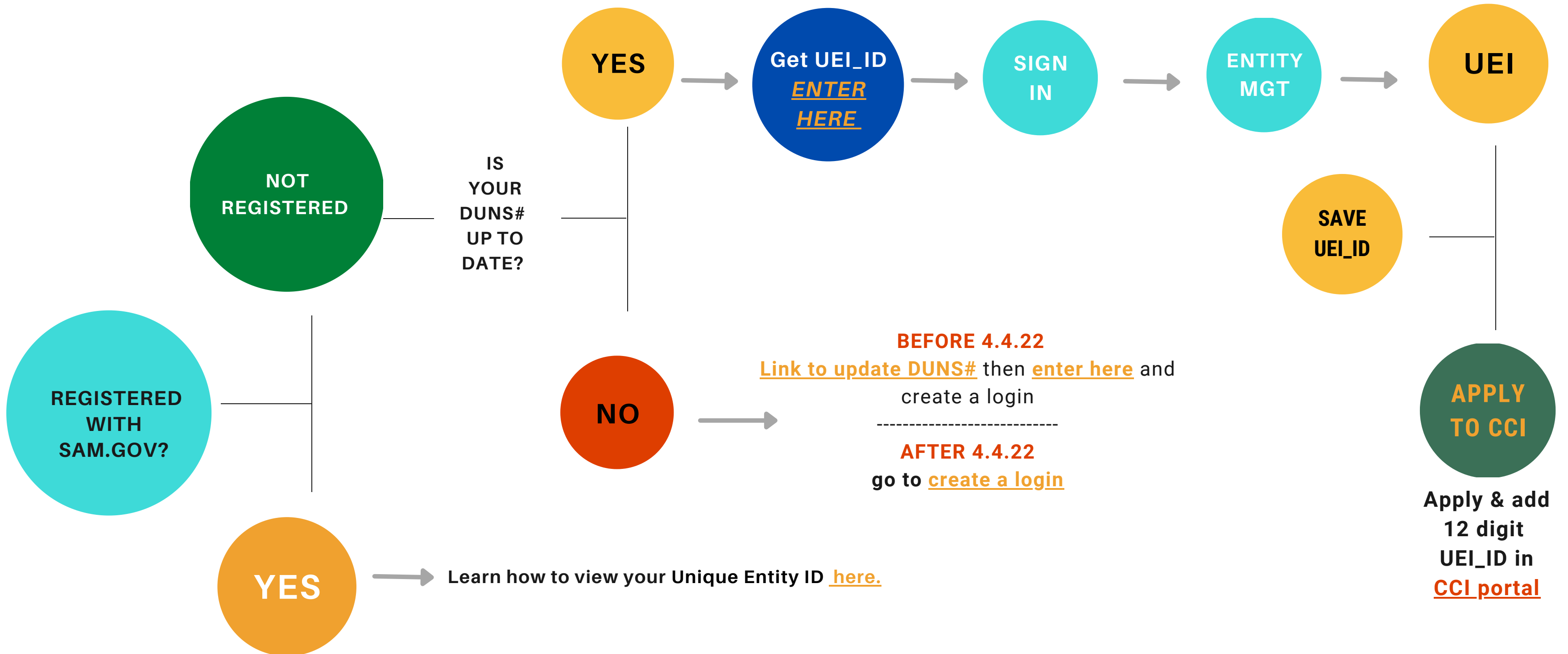


IF YOUR ENTITY CURRENTLY HAS A DUNS# ...BUT IS NOT REGISTERED IN SAM.GOV



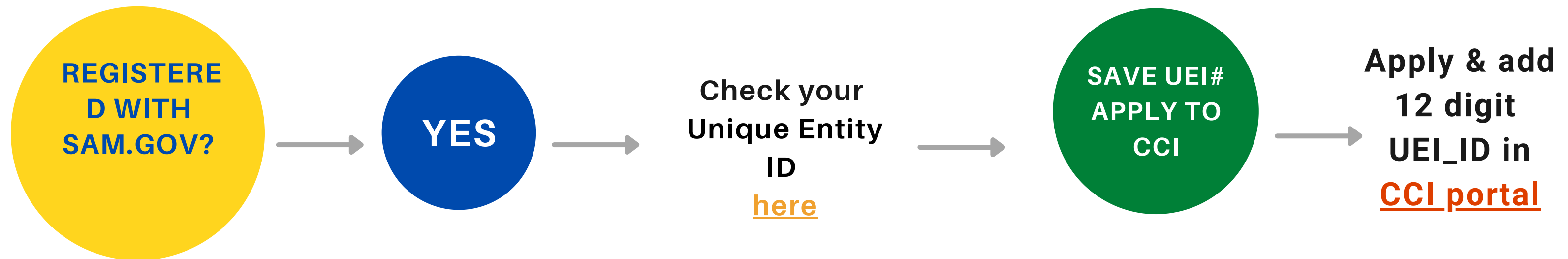
If your entity only needs to get a Unique Entity ID (SAM), and does not want to complete a full entity registration in SAM.gov. If you have an active or inactive registration in SAM.gov today, you've already been assigned a Unique Entity ID (SAM).

If you have an active or inactive registration in SAM.gov today, you've already been assigned a Unique Entity ID (SAM).



IF YOUR ENTITY DOES NOT HAVE DUNS# ...& IS NOT REGISTERED IN SAM.GOV



- Your entity does not have a DUNS Number and today's date is **before April 4, 2022**. Before April 4, 2022, the DUNS Number issued by Dun & Bradstreet is the authoritative entity identifier used by the federal government. You need to get a DUNS Number first before you can request a Unique Entity ID (SAM).
- Your entity does not have a DUNS Number and today's date is **after April 4, 2022**. After April 4, 2022, the federal government will have no requirement for the DUNS Number. You can get a Unique Entity ID (SAM) for your entity on SAM.gov.
